2 Days of Downhill Mountain Bike Racing

SATURDAY, AUGUST 13 ON BLAZE

This race will open up a weekend of Downhill racing action at Pomerelle Resort. Saturday's race will feature a 1-Run competition that will count for full series points. This race runs down the "Blaze" course. The race features an incredible start through a field of wildflowers and then a twisting, high-speed descent through the forest. This course is challenging but less technical than Sunday's trail.

Day #1 Start Times

Racing begins at 1:30 p.m. with Cat 2 and Novice on course first. Pros and Cat 1's will start shortly after the completion of the Novice classes. Please be at the start gate early. Start times will be set and posted Saturday at 12:30 p.m. at the base of the chair lift. You should be loading on the lift no later than 30 minutes prior to your official start time. Racers will go at 1-minute intervals.

SUNDAY, AUGUST 14 ON POUNDER

This race will descend the classic "Pounder" course that made downhill racing so popular at Pomerelle. This track is rough, tough and steep. Novice racers will descend a very fun but less technical course.

Day #2 Start Times

Racing begins at 11 a.m. with Novice on course first. Pros, Cat 1's and Cat 2's will start shortly after the completion of the Novice class. Please be at the start gate early. You should be loading on the lift no later than 30 minutes prior to your start time. Start times will be posted at 9 a.m. at the base of the chair lift. The race will be a 1-run format with 1 minute intervals.

AWARDS AND RAFFLES

Award ceremony will be a 5 p.m. on Saturday and a.s.a.p. after the race on Sunday. Raffle prizes will be distributed during the race. The race announcer will notify winners via P.A. announcements. Winning tickets will be listed on a board at the prize tent. All prizes will be available for pick-up at the prize tent.

PRACTICE & LIFT RIDE INFORMATION

All courses will be ready for inspection from Saturday morning on. Lift fees are NOT included in your entry fee. You must purchase a lift pass for each day you plan on riding the lift. Rates are \$25 per day. A "Race Weekend Special" for both Saturday and Sunday of \$35 will be available to racers.

This is a special weekend at Pomerelle since the lift will be running on Friday from 3 to 6 p.m and a special Fri., Sat., Sun. lift pass will cost just \$45.

PARKING/CAMPING INFORMATION

Plentiful parking is available at the Resort Base and you can camp in the resort parking lot. It's about 20 miles to the nearest lodging so plan on making it a camp-out-weekend! There are Forest Service campsites nearby, but the parking lot at Pomerelle is really a great place for either tents or self-contained RV's. Please make sure you're aware of any COVID-19 or open-fire restrictions and plan on packing out all that you pack in. Pomerelle's Web site has a link to local lodging options.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Early registration fee for entries postmarked by Saturday, August 6, 2022 is \$70 per race, or the 2-race discounted fee is \$105.

Add \$5.00 for on-site registration. Cash or check only for on-site registration.

On-site registration fee is \$75 per race and the 2-race discount is \$110.

Please don't mail your entries in late, you can still sign up at Pomerelle for Day 1 Saturday morning until 10 a.m. and for Day 2 at 5:30 p.m. on Saturday. **NO Sunday Reg**, packet pickup only on Sunday morning from 8:30 to 9:00 a.m.

On-site registration at Pomerelle on Friday, August 12 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Saturday, August 13 from 9 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (**Race # 1 reg. closes at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday**) and again on Saturday afternoon from 5 to 5:30 p.m.

Unlicensed Cat 2 and Novice riders must purchase a 1-day USAC license for each day they race. 1-day licenses are \$10/day and can be purchased at registration at Pomerelle (cash or check only).

USA Cycling Racing Memberships will be available for purchase at on-site registration. USAC racing licenses are \$99 for Cat 1, Cat 2 and Novice are valid for one calendar year for the date of purchase.

Junior racers--18 & under racing licenses are free.

Unlicensed Cat 2 and Novice riders must purchase a 1-day USAC license for each day they race. 1-day licenses are \$10/day and can be purchased at on-site registration (cash or check only). A one time 1-day license for Cat 1 racers without a racing license is available on-line, prior to the race, at www.usacycling.org.

Pro and Cat 1 racers must have a valid 2022 USAC annual racing license. Pro licenses cannot be purchased or upgraded at this event. Go to www.usacycling.org to process these licenses.
